INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS 2008 – 2009

The members of the Mountain View Marching Band have established themselves as an integral part of the spirit and pride of Mountain View High School. This dynamic group of young musicians performs regularly at all home football games and provides the excitement and pageantry that is an integral part of high school football. The band works with the cheerleaders, dance team and football team to provide an exciting, spirited atmosphere for the entire school community.

The Mountain View Marching Band also competes in field show competitions and parades during the fall season representing our school across the state of Virginia. The group has rapidly improved, having recently been named a “Virginia Honor Band” in only their second year.

The pageantry and excitement of the marching band is enhanced by an outstanding Color Guard. This group combines dance with visual implements to visually express the band’s music. Color Guard is open to any student at Mountain View and auditions for this exciting group are held in May of each year.

Involvement in the Mountain View Marching Band is an outstanding part of any student’s musical learning. It helps to build life skills of teamwork, cooperation, responsibility, and leadership. Additionally, participation in marching band helps to give students a sense of belonging and helps to develop a student’s positive self-image which will, in turn, help them toward higher self-esteem. Most importantly, participation in the Mountain View Marching Band will generate exciting times, friendships and memories that will last a lifetime. For students new to MVHS, band camp provides an opportunity to begin the school year with a supportive and positive group of new friends.

Membership in the Marching Band is open to any student enrolled in a band class at MVHS. We encourage you to get involved and we look forward to welcoming you as a member of our band family at Mountain View High School.

Marching Band Camp Dates

Marching Band Reading Session: Thursday, June 5th from 6:00pm to 8:00pm. This will be our first opportunity to work together. Students will be introduced to their new “band family” and will be introduced to the music for our fall competition show.

Drum Line & Color Guard Camp: We will have a one-week, intensive training session for all members of the marching drum line & color guard. Our outstanding marching percussion & color guard staff will begin working with the students on techniques and skills needed to be an award-winning drum line & color guard for the 2008 season!

Band Camp begins in August with orientation days for our new members. The entire group begins working together on Monday, August 11. We will have a week of music rehearsals followed by a week of learning drill. During these early days of band camp we work a four day week, Monday through Thursday, from 8:00am until 4:00pm. All students *must* attend *all* band camp rehearsals to be full participants in marching band.

Required Items

Band Fees for All Members

Returning Band Members	\$200.00
New Band Members	\$225.00

The member fees for participation in marching band include uniform rental and maintenance fees, instruction, entry fees for competitions and the cost for travel to marching band festivals. In addition to the fee for returning members, the additional cost for new members includes the "informal uniform" polo shirt, MV Band cap and required music folio. Returning members will need to pay the additional cost if replacements for the items are needed. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is due before the end of the current school year to reserve your position in the marching band as the drill and music are prepared for you during the summer months.

Instrument Rental and marching band shoes are not included in the member fee as these needs vary by member and section of the band.

All students using a school-owned instrument must pay this fee required by the Stafford County Public Schools. This fee covers basic use of all school instruments for the entire school year. Students using multiple instruments (marching and concert) need only pay one fee. An Instrumental Rental Contract must be completed by the student and parent and returned before instrument issue.
