All County Band Hosting Notes 2006

Friday --

Breakfast type items for Directors room and for student volunteers.

Mid morning concessions – Ellen bought individually wrapped muffins (60) and dunking sticks (1 box, approx. 12), granola bars (50 bars). Sold water and sodas.

Lunch for directors

Lunch for All County Students:

Ordered pizza from Sams. 20 pizzas(8 slices per pizza). \$1/slice. Sold candy bars, sodas, water, muffins. All muffins sold by lunchtime.

Mid afternoon concessions – sold from concession stand.

Need change

Volunteers needed for lunch for directors, 4 student helpers, 2 parent chaperones to pick up pizza, oversee money and concessions

Saturday.

Breakfast items for directors and student volunteers.

Lunch for everyone in cafeteria – spaghetti, bread, salad, dessert. Served about 90 – 75 kids at \$3, 6 directors, 10 volunteers

7 crock pots of sauce – used 5 (approx. 20 servings per crock pot. Kids loved the meatballs and sauce!)

20 pounds of spaghetti noodles. Noodles were cooked the night before and packed in Ziploc bags. We reheated in hot water and the microwave and used a large roaster pan.
